Meetings & Workshops

Mactoberfest: Held each October, it is the most popular HMAUS function. This all day event includes vendor presentations, workshops, help clinics, computer swap meet, door prizes and more.

Mac SpringFest: Held each March or April, it is the second most popular HMAUS function. This all day event includes vendor presentations, workshops, help clinics, computer swap meet, student photography contest, door prizes and more.

HOTS: Students learn how to use hardware and software in workshop series of one more workshops per seminar.
